Dear AHBC Saints,

As I was reading my Bible this week and preparing for my sermon series from Romans, I thought about Paul as he wrote the letter to the Romans and his letters to the other churches, like the Ephesians or to the church at Galatia, I wondered if he imagined that his words would still be being read and taught over 2000 years later. These were letters written to the local churches to be shared with everyone there as was their practice. Then I wondered if any of my own words are worthy of that kind of a legacy? I have preached, on the average of 48 ~50 sermons a year since 1984. That is roughly 1800 Sunday morning sermons alone. That doesn't count Wednesday night messages or other small group teaching that I have done over the years. I always am praying that everything that I preach and teach will reach some people to get saved if they have not yet been introduced to Jesus or to walk closer to Jesus if they are already saved.

I am in a position to possibly reach more folks for Jesus than the average person as a pastor. However, the 11 remaining disciples, after they received the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, went out and turned the world upside down for Jesus. It cost most of them their lives. The last thing Jesus told His disciples was to go to ALL the world and make disciples. If 11 men can change the world without programs, praise bands, and seminary trained preachers, what do you suppose God can do with you and the same simple message to "Repent and Believe for the Kingdom of God is near"? God's method of church growth is geometric. If you reach 1 other person then there are 2 of you to reach 2 more, then there are 4 of you to reach 4 more, and so on and so on.

How much will our church grow if every adult in our church were to reach just one person in the next year and bring them to church and Sunday school with you? Is that too difficult? It IS if you try to do it without the Lord's help. Ask God to give you ONE person for you to build a friendship with so that you will reach a point of trust that you can share with them about your relationship with Jesus and invite them to come to church with you and your family. This is God's deal, not yours or mine. If we are faithful to love God with all of our heart and to love our Neighbor as ourselves, God will do it. Will YOUDOIT???





Greetings from Fremont Nebraska! I'm with Alayna visiting Midland University where she will be attending college starting in August. She has worked so hard and has earned a powerlifting scholarship to continue lifting at the college level. To God be the Glory!

For the last 15 years I have been able to preach, teach, and counsel without having to deal with my own struggles that I have stored up for so long. It all came to a head on morning and that little file box where I stored everything came flying open. I've never felt so much shame come over me at one time. I knew if I wanted to continue in ministry I was going to need to get some help. So, since January, I meet with a counselor with STCH on Mondays. There are days I don't want to meet, but I know God knows what's best for me. I know this is a process…it's not a sprint, it's a marathon. For God to bring healing in my life, I have to trust the process.

Last weekend I was the Spiritual leader for a Women's Grace Retreat. When I was asked to lead I did not want to do it, but looking back, I'm glad I did. One verse kept coming up during the retreat. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 says, "Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Jesus Christ." This hit me like a ton a bricks. I've read this so many times but it never meant so much like it did last weekend and right now! I'm so thankful for what God is doing right now in my life.

I can *rejoice always* because it's God that's leading me through the fire. All I have to do is have the strength to hold His hand through the fire. I can also rejoice because I know the fire will refine me and make me stronger. God will turn this mess of mine and use it for His Good.

I have to *pray continually* and keep God's Word close to my heart. The only way I can get through this is to stay close to God, dig into God's Word, and rest in His arms knowing He will give me the strength when I am week.

This next one is hard to do. *Give thanks in all circumstances*. Why do I have to give thanks in ALL circumstances? I can give thanks because every trial I go through I know I have a Savior that loves me, cares for me, and wants to hold me up when I can't stand. I give thanks because I know this trial I'm going through will not last forever. I give thanks because of the next part of the passage...

For this is God's will for you in Jesus Christ. I can rejoice always and give thanks to God because this is God's will for me! God said to me, "The time is Now!" Now is the time to deal will the garbage I was holding on to. The fire purifies, refines, reshapes, and God wants me to go through this with Him.

What are you going through right now? What have you pushed away for so long that keeps weighing on you? For God to use you like He wants, you have to empty yourselves to God and give Him everything that hinders you. Know that you are not alone when you walk through the flames. It's God's will for your life. Know that you need Jesus to get through. God gives you a group of people that loves you, NO MATTER WHAT! This group of people is called Alamo Heights Baptist Church. That's why we exist! Not to judge, but to be used by God to help nurture and equip the believers of Jesus Christ to live a life that honors God.

I'm so thankful I went on this retreat. God spoke and I needed it! God gives me the strength right now to share with you because someone reading this is going through the fire. God is so Good!
